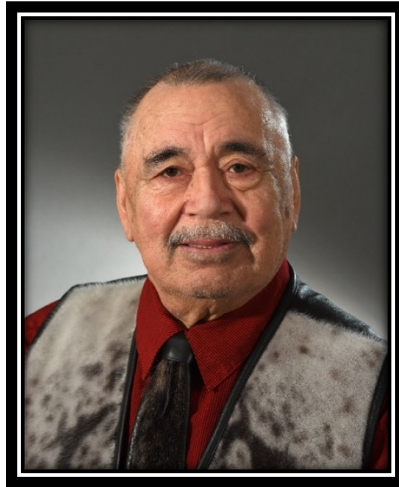


MR. LUDY PUDLUK SCHOLARSHIP



In memory of Mr. Ludy Pudluk, Qikiqtaaluk Corporation Group of Companies have developed a Scholarship to honor his commitment and contributions. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide assistance to an eligible student pursuing studies in the areas of Political Studies, Fisheries Development and Environmental Studies.

Established in 2020 by Qikiqtaaluk Corporation to honor Mr. Ludy Pudluk, who served as a Board of Director for Qikiqtaaluk Corporation and Group of Companies for over 20 year. His leadership within the Board has influenced many achievements and growth within the group of companies and ensured Qikiqtaaluk Corporation operated using management and financial best practices.

Given in memory for his outstanding contribution, Ludy had a strong sense of governance, and ensured there was sound strategic development. He was also an advocate with community engagement and was highly supportive of offshore/inshore fisheries within the region.

Ludy was born on January 31, 1943, at an outpost camp called Qaumarjuit near Pond Inlet. In 1958, he moved with his father's family to Resolute Bay, where he married and raised his family. In recent years, Ludy moved back to the community of Pond Inlet where he resided until his passing in 2019 at the age of 76.

Scholarship Requirements:

- Eligible applicants must be a Qikiqtani Region Beneficiary of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement;
- Eligible applicants must be enrolled in a full-time diploma, undergraduate degree-seeking course of study or a designated apprenticeship program at a recognized, accredited educational institution in Canada;
- Eligible applicants may be enrolled in any area of studies; however, preference will be given to eligible students pursuing studies in the areas of Political Studies, Fisheries Development and Environmental Studies.
- Selected students are awarded a scholarship of \$6,000 per academic year;
- Successful applicants will receive scholarship funds in two installment payments of \$3,000 each. The first installment will be provided upon the successful approval of scholarship application. The second and final installment will be awarded at the successful completion of the course of studies for the academic year upon QC receiving first and second semester grades.
